One of the Columbia Heights Jamboree's premier events is our Jamboree Parade. Every year, about 100 entries march, wave, and cheer on the fourth Friday in June to celebrate our wonderful community. As always, the parade route starts at 45th Avenue NE and Central Avenue NE. It then travels south on Central Avenue NE, and then heads west along 40th Avenue NE. The parade then heads west to 5th Street NE where the parade ends.

There are plenty of viewing locations along the sidewalks of the parade route to set up and watch. Come early and pick a spot and plan for a fun time. Free public parking is also available on-street and in public parking lots and ramps.

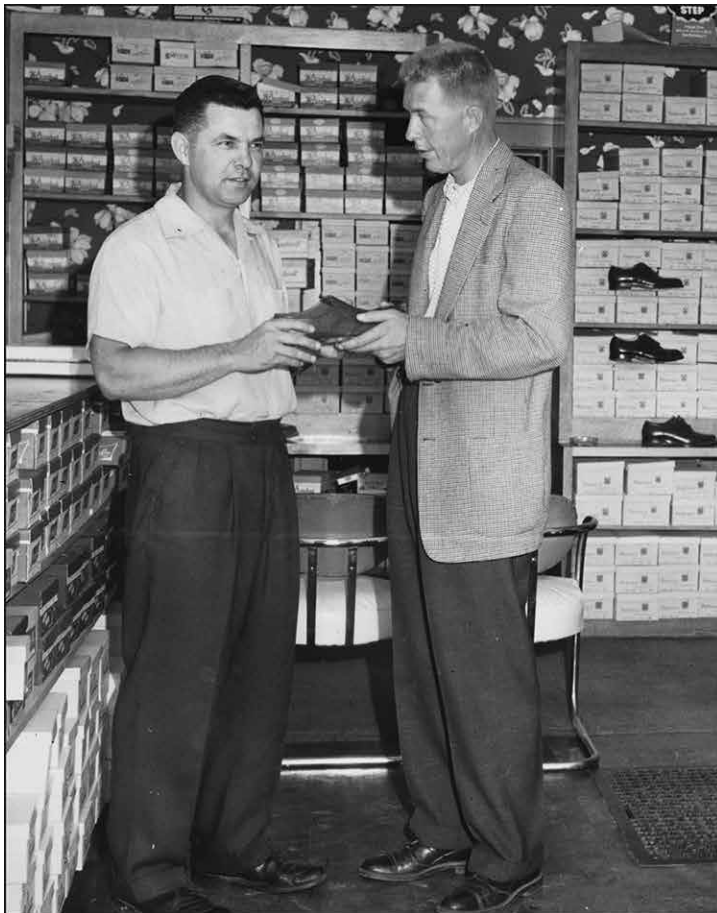

Columbia Heights' 2019 Outstanding Citizen

Catherine Miske Named 2019 Winner of Annual Award

The kind of people who get nominated for Columbia Heights' Outstanding Citizen Award tend to have a healthy dose of humility. So when Catherine Miske received a call from Columbia Heights City Hall, she assumed she was in trouble.

"At first I thought, 'why is the City calling me, is my yard not up to standard? Are there too many toys out front?'" Miske said. The City was actually calling to inform her she had been selected as the 2019 Outstanding Citizen winner.

Miske was nominated by Katherine Hosch and Cheri Fischer, who highlighted Miske's work as a Cub Scout volunteer at Immaculate Conception Church and liturgy coordinator at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, where she works with Deaf and hard-of-hearing youth. She hosts Boy Scout programs out of her house, and regularly arranges to bring kids to area nursing homes to sing songs, play games, and do projects with the residents.

Miske moved to Columbia Heights in 1986 and raised three children here. She has been a volunteer for the Columbia Heights Public Schools reading and theater programs. She has also stepped in to help with youth programs at the Columbia Heights Public Library when the library was short-staffed.



"I think part of the responsibility of living in a community is to support it and try to give back as much as you can," Miske said.

Miske was selected from a group of nominees by Mayor Donna Schmitt and last year's Outstanding Citizen winner Tanya Moore.

About the Outstanding Citizen Award

Do you know of someone making a positive impact in your community? Someone who's gone unrecognized for all the great things they have done and continue to do to make the City a better place? Every year Columbia Heights seeks nominations for Outstanding Citizen (formally Humanitarian of the Year).

Nominations can be submitted by anyone. The only requirement is that those who are nominated live in Columbia Heights. The selection process gives extra consideration to people who have not otherwise been publicly recognized. The deadline to submit nominations for the 2020 Outstanding Citizen of the Year will be next May, but it's not too early to start thinking about the people in your community who are going above and beyond to make this City a better place to live.

City Employee of the Year Award Goes to Public Works Superintendent

Thirty-four years ago, the City Council approved the Employee of the Year Award as a method of rewarding employees seen by their peers and supervisors as deserving of special recognition for their accomplishments and contributions to the City of Columbia Heights.

This year, Mike O'Reilly, street and parks superintendent, became the 39th employee to receive the honor. Described by those who nominated him as having a 'get it done' attitude, O'Reilly has worked for the City since 1979, when he started as a maintenance worker. He is often the first person to be called when other City departments need help, and there's no counting the number of times he has responded to emergency after-hour situations, or has woken up in the middle of the night to determine if

the roads need to be plowed. O'Reilly has overseen a cohesive operation for City-owned street lights, a reduction in the City's salt usage, and the reworking of the Municipal Service Center storage yard to accommodate all of Public Works activities, including storm water treatment. He also helped maximize the efficiency of the City's snow plowing operations and guided the change from reactive to proactive snow management.

"We honor him for being an asset, not just to Public Works, but to our community, to our entire workplace, and our lives," said Mayor Donna Schmitt. "This award has been a long-time coming."

On an annual basis, each employee is given the opportunity to nominate themselves or another employee for

the Employee of the Year Award based on three criteria: Public Relations, Consistency of Performance, and Significant Accomplishments. The committee who reviews nominations and chooses the Employee of the Year is composed of former Employee of the Year recipients who are still employed by the City.

THE HISTORY OF LIONS CLUB



Chicago insurance man Melvin Jones (pictured) is credited as being the man who started the International Association of Lions Clubs. From his own club, the Business Circle of Chicago, he convinced other community leaders to form a national club that would be dedicated not only to networking for business and social reasons, but to better the communities all over.

At a local hotel on June 7, 1917, twelve men gathered and voted the **Association of Lions Clubs** into existence. A call for a national convention led to one held in Dallas, Texas in October of the same year. Thirty-six delegates representing twenty-two clubs from nine states heeded the call, approved the Lions Clubs designation, and elected Dr. William P. Woods of Indiana as their first president. Guiding force and founder Melvin Jones was named as acting secretary. Thus began an association with Lionism that only ended with his death in 1961.

That first convention also began to define what Lionism was to become. One of the main tenets of Lionism ever since reads **"No club shall hold out the financial betterment of its members as its object."**



Community leaders soon began to organize clubs throughout the United States, and the association became international with the formation of the Windsor, Ontario, Canada Lions Club in 1920. Expansion continued with the addition of clubs in China (1926), Mexico and Cuba (1927), Central America (starting with Panama in 1935), South America (starting with Colombia in 1936), Europe (1948), and Japan (1952).

Women were admitted to Lions in 1987 (for the second time), the first Lions Club for youth was organized in 1957, and the "Sight First" program was launched in 1990.

Now Lions is the world's largest and most active service organization, with nearly 1.4 million members in more than 45,000 clubs covering 206 countries and geographical areas.

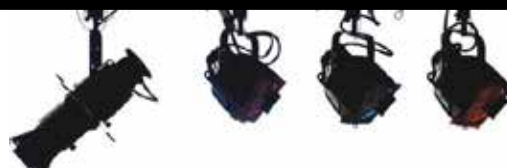
